

## Map From Logan Airport to NECCE Durham, NH



**Driving time approximately 1.5 hrs.**

1. As you leave the airport, bear to the right heading North on Route 1A. As you come down the ramp from the airport onto route 1A, there will be three lanes of traffic, move into the center or far-left lane.
2. In approximately 3 miles you will come to the junction Route 60 West. At this point make sure you are in one of the two left lanes so you can bear left (traffic light) onto Route 60 (leaving Route 1A).
3. After several traffic lights you will come to a Rotary. You need to go half way around it so you can essentially keep going straight on Route 60 West.
4. You will pass the North Gate Shopping Plaza and will enter another rotary. Stay in the right lane so you can take the first exit which is marked Route 1 North (to 95) (NH, Maine). Once you enter Route 1, stay in the center lane, which in time will become the right lane when there are only two lanes.
5. In approximately 8 more miles, or so, you will see signs to Interstate Hwy. 95 NORTH. CAUTION: One mile before you get to 95 North, you will pass the exit to 95 South. Make sure you watch for the NORTH and also it will be marked "NH - Maine" -- that's the one you want. It is the two right lanes that exit. From this point to the Hampton, NH Toll Plaza (\$1.00) is approximately 32 miles.
6. Approximately 8 miles North of the Toll Plaza get into one of 2 left lanes and bear LEFT for EXIT 4 and follow the signs marked Spaulding Turnpike, Route 4, Route 16. Various signs will also mention Dover, White Mtns., NH Lakes. Be sure to get off 95 at this point or you will go off into Maine.
7. You will pass a Ford dealer on the right and a large shopping center. You will go over a bridge and very shortly come to a junction of Route 16 and Route 4. Go under the overpass and take Exit 6W, (Route 4) which will be just before the tollhouse (you should not go through the tollbooth).
8. Continue West on route 4 for several miles. You will pass the junction of Route 108. Continue on Route 4. You will then come to a traffic light at the junction of Madbury Road - Turn Left. This is a residential street.
9. In less than a mile, you will come up a short incline where you should turn right. This is Edgewood and on the corner is a sign for several university facilities including NEW ENGLAND CENTER.
10. At the next intersection, turn left and you will see the New England Center entrance a few hundred feet on the right.

# MANCHESTER AIRPORT TO NECCE – DURHAM NH

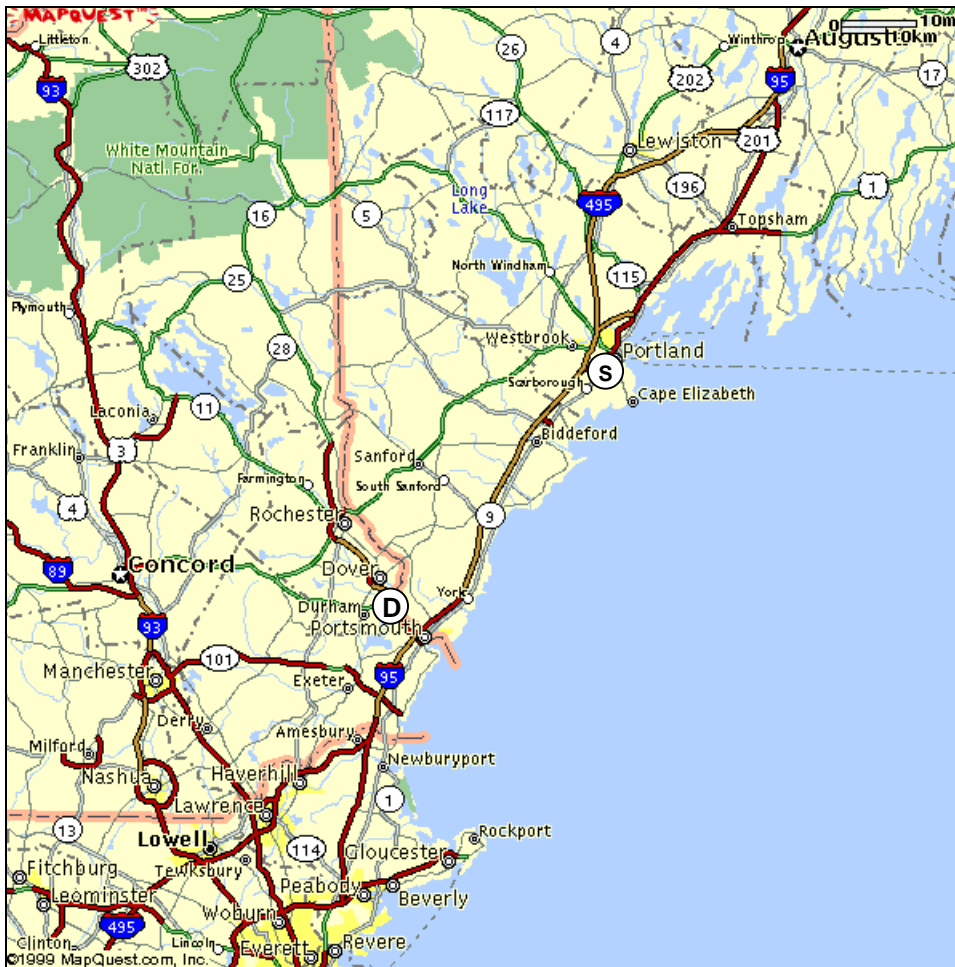


**S = Start**

**Driving time approximately 1 hr.**

1.	Exit airport, turn right & follow signs to I-293 East
2.	Merge onto I-293 S/SR-101 East
3.	Take the I-93 NORTH/RT-101 EAST exit left towards CONCORD/PORTSMOUTH
4.	Take the I-93 N/SR-101 EAST exit, exit number 7, towards PORTSMOUTH/SEACOAST
5.	Take the RT-125 Exit, exit number 7, towards EPPING/KINGSTON
6.	Turn LEFT onto SR-125 North
7.	Stay straight to go onto US-4 East
8.	At traffic circle take RT-4 EAST
9.	Go to first traffic light & turn RIGHT onto Madbury Rd.
10.	In less than one mile is a 4-way stop, turn RIGHT onto (EDGEWOOD)
11.	At the next intersection, turn left and you will see the New England Center on the right

# PORTLAND AIRPORT MAP



Driving time approximately 1.5 hrs.

1. Take right onto Congress Street and go 1.5 miles to Interstate 295 right, sign will say South Portland. Go down 295 to turnpike thru tool gate. Travel down turnpike until you get to Portsmouth NH and take Spaulding Turnpike (North to Dover), Route 4, Route 16. Various signs will also mention Dover, White Mtns., NH Lakes. Be sure to get off 95 at this point or you will be headed to Boston MA.
2. You will pass a Ford dealer on the right and a large shopping center. You will go over a bridge and very shortly come to a junction of Route 16 and Route 4. Go under the overpass and take Exit 6W, (Route 4) which will be just before the toll house (you should not get through the toll booth).
3. Continue West on route 4 for several miles. You will pass the junction of Route 108. Continue on Route 4. You will then come to a traffic light at the junction of Madbury Road - Turn Left. This is a residential street.
4. In less than a mile, you will come up a short incline to a 4-way stop where you should turn right. This is Edgewood and on the corner is a sign for several university facilities including NEW ENGLAND CENTER.
5. At the next intersection, turn left and you will see the New England Center entrance a few hundred feet on the right.
